

Girl Scout Parents & Guardians:

How Can You Help During the Cookie Program?

Although the Cookie Program is fun, there are many moving parts for girls to achieve their goal. Whether you can spare a little or a lot of time, there is a place for you to help the troop!

Below are some ways you can help support the troop during the Cookie Program:

- Help transport girls to/from booth sales
- Be a runner at a booth (restroom breaks)
- Cookie supply runner (refill cookies at booths when they run out in middle of a shift)
- Pick up Troop Initial Cookie Order from delivery site
- Pick up cookies for troop from Cupboard during the week
- Help count and sort girls' orders for pick up
- Collect cookie money from parents during the meeting/other agreed location
- Chaperone cookie booths with troop girls
- Volunteer to take the deposits to the bank every week
- Pick up the booth and set it up or pick it up at the end of the booth and take it back to where cookies are stored
- Gather girl orders every week by deadline day for Troop Cookie Chair
- Plan an activity for your troop meeting
- Volunteer to help with troop communications to Girl Scout families (via social media/text/email)
